Greystone Immigration ("we", "us", or "our") respects your privacy and knows that you care about protecting your personal information. This privacy policy (the "Privacy Policy") identifies what information we collect from you when you use www.greystoneimmigration.com (the "Website", including all subdomains) and the services made available on it (the "Services") and explains how we may use or share that information. This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect from you on the Website; through the Services; in email; text, and other electronic correspondence; and through any mobile or desk application through which we may communicate. This Privacy Policy does not apply to information we collect offline or that any third party collects from you after you follows links on the Website, including any advertising and affiliate links.

i. Consent

YOU MAY NOT ACCESS OR USE THIS WEBSITE OR THE SERVICES IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO ANY PART OF THESE TERMS. WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO PERIODICALLY MAKE UPDATES TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY AS OUR PRACTICES CHANGE. ii. Collection of Personal Information

When you access our Website, our servers may automatically record information that your browser sends. This includes information such as your device's IP address, browser type and version, operating system type and version, language preferences or the webpage you were visiting before you came to the Website and Services, pages of the Website and Services that you visit, the time spent on those pages, information you search for on the Website, access times and dates, and other statistics information collected automatically is used only to identify potential cases of abuse, and to establish statistical information regarding the usage and traffic of the Website and Services. We also collect personal information directly from you as detailed herein, when you voluntarily provide it to us for the purposes of engaging in our Services. - Geolocation data such as latitude and longitude
- Information about other individuals such as your spouse, children, or other family members, etc.
- Billing, payment, and financial information
- Any other materials or information you willingly submit to us or that we legally require

You can access and use the Website without telling us who you are or revealing any information by which someone could identify you as a specific, identifiable individual. If, however, you wish use to our Services you will be asked to provide certain personal information necessary for us to communicate with you, confirm your identity, and assess your eligibility for the Services that we may be offering at that time. We receive and store any information you knowingly provide to us when you fill any online forms on the Website.

We may also collect your information from other persons with your consent or as authorized by law.

iii. Retention of Personal Information

- Bill and process payments

v. Sharing Your Information

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information. This does not include affiliated entities controlled by us or under common direct or indirect control, trusted third parties who assist us in operating the Website, conducting our business, or servicing you, or third-party vendors or service providers (including third parties that are located in countries other than your own), so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential.

Depending on the requested Services or as necessary to complete any transaction or provide any service you have requested, we may share your information with your consent with our trusted third parties that work with us, any other affiliates and subsidiaries we rely upon to assist in the operation of the Website and Services available to you. We do not share personal information with unaffiliated third parties. These service providers are not authorized to use or disclose your information except as necessary to perform services on our behalf or comply with legal requirements. We may share your personal information for these purposes only with third parties whose privacy policies are consistent with ours or who agree to abide by our policies with respect to personal information. These third parties are given personal information they need only in order to perform their designated functions, and we do not authorize them to use or disclose personal information for their own marketing or other purposes.

We will disclose any personal information we collect, use or receive if required or permitted by law, such as to comply with a subpoena, or similar legal process, and when we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights, protect your safety or the safety of others, investigate fraud, or respond to a government request.

vi. Privacy of Children

We do not knowingly collect any personal information from children under the age of 18. If you are under the age of 18; please do not submit any personal information through the Website and Services. We encourage parents and legal guardians to monitor their children's internet usage.

vii. Cookies

Our Website may now or in the future use cookies without further notice. Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your web browser (if you allow) that enable the site's or service provider's systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information. You may change the setting so your browser may either refuse all cookies or informs you when a cookie is being sent.

Our Website may use cookies to understand and save your preferences for future visits and to compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better experiences. Google Analytics, and other services, use cookies to help Greystone Immigration analyze how visitors browse a site. No information is transferred to such services (which gather all information directly through cookies or similar methods). The information these services gather about your use of the Website and/or Platform is retained by Google in accordance with their Terms of Service available on their websites.

We may embed content from other sites such as YouTube (videos) and social media sites such as Facebook, LinkedIn and Twitter. We have no control over whether embedded content sets a cookie on your browser or not.

viii. Links to Other Websites

Our Website may contain links to or features from other websites, applications, services, etc. (for example, Acuity Scheduling, Google, Facebook, Instagram). This Privacy Policy covers only the policies of the Greystone Immigration Website and not of any other websites, applications, or services. Greystone Immigration is NOT responsible for the privacy policies of third parties. If you choose to link to a third-party website, application, or service you should be sure to read the privacy policy of that specific website, application, or service.

ix. Do Not Track Signals
